This autumn, as part of their commitment to be environmentally friendly, Wiltshire-based condiment maker, Tracklements, are calling for the local community to donate their unwanted medlar fruit. Tracklements turns this peculiar fruit into their delightful Aromatic Medlar Jelly, where 50p from the sale of each jar goes towards helping the bees.

25p from the sale of each jar allows us to purchase bee-friendly medlar trees, which blossom later in the year, after other blossoms have faded, providing an invaluable source of pollen.

25p from each jar sold is donated to the British Beekeepers' Association, a charity committed to promoting the importance of and protecting the British honeybee.

The project is now in its 14th year and has helped plant almost 200 beautiful bee-friendly medlar trees across Britain and has contributed to Tracklements donating over £3,000 to the British Beekeepers' Association last year alone!
